Professor David Gallo, PhD, studied engineering before changing his major to economics during his undergraduate years. He received his B.A. degree at Penn State University and his M.A. and PhD. Degrees at the University of Oregon. He has been teaching at California State University, Chico since 1970, specializing in environmental and energy economics. Dr. Gallo has been a consultant to the California Energy Commission and is currently doing research with the Center for Economic Development at CSU, Chico (CED).
